23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

E Yesler Way partial intersection closure: Weekdays from September 14 – 25

The intersection of E Yesler Way and 23rd Ave will be partially closed to through traffic on weekdays from Monday, September 14 to Friday, September 25. Southbound traffic on 23rd Ave will be maintained at all times, and the intersection will be opened to east and westbound traffic over the weekends of September 19 and September 26. During the weekday closures, crews will complete the demolition and paving work originally scheduled for the weekend of August 29 that was postponed due to the weather.

Work hours and impacts

- Crews will work at the intersection on weekdays from Monday, September 14 to Friday, September 25.
- Noise, dust, and vibration expected throughout normal daytime work hours.
- There is no scheduled nighttime or weekend work planned for the E Yesler Way intersection.
- This work is dependent on weather and may need to be rescheduled.
- Additional work at this intersection may also be required.

Transit, bicycle and pedestrian information

- Metro bus route #27 and its bus stops will be affected by this work. Look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000.
- Bicyclists should also detour around the intersection during this work.
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained.
- Flaggers and uniformed police officers will be present to assist pedestrians and manage traffic.

Access to businesses

- Customers can continue to access businesses by car, by driving into the local access areas, or on foot.
- Please continue to support your local businesses!

Traffic impacts

- The E Yesler Way intersection at 23rd Ave will be closed to eastbound and westbound traffic for two weeks:
 - **Week 1:** Crews will work on the west side of the intersection. See the “Week 1” map on reverse side for traffic closure and detour details.
 - **Week 2:** Crews will work on the east side of the intersection. See the “Week 2” map on reverse side for traffic closure and detour details.
- The intersection will be open to eastbound and westbound traffic during the weekends.
- 23rd Ave will remain open to southbound traffic at all times.
- The northbound 23rd Ave detour to Martin Luther King Jr Way will remain in place.
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; follow the signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets.



