

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

July 21, 2015

23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

Overnight work planned for the Jackson St intersection July 24 - 27

Starting as early as 9 PM on Friday, July 24, through 6 AM on Monday, July 27, access to the intersection of S Jackson Street and 23rd Avenue S will be closed to traffic. This weekend closure is necessary for crews to continue demolition and paving work in the intersection and at the crosswalk areas.

Work hours and impacts

- Crews will work continuously (all hours) starting as early as **9 PM, Friday, July 24 through 6 AM, Monday, July 27.**
- Neighbors can expect noise, dust and vibration from dumping and hauling activities throughout all hours of the weekend.
- On Friday night, work until 11 PM will be especially noisy because the contractor will be working hard to complete concrete breaking.
- The temporary noise variance to perform this work has been approved and permits crews to work throughout the night and early morning.
- We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience.

Traffic impacts


- The intersection will be completely closed to traffic.
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; please follow signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets.
- Local access to residents and businesses will be provided.
- The northbound 23rd Avenue detour to Martin Luther King Jr Way will remain in place.

Transit, bicycle and pedestrian info

- Metro bus routes #14 and #48 will be affected by this work; look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000.
- Bicyclists should also detour around the intersection during this work.
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained.
- Flaggers and uniformed police officers will be present to assist pedestrians and manage traffic.

Future weekend intersection work

- One to two additional weekends of construction can be expected in the Jackson St intersection for electrical and asphalt paving work.
- These weekend closures are not expected to occur until September and will likely be the final closures for the Jackson St intersection.
