## 23rd Avenue Corridor Improvements Project

**E Jefferson Street intersection closure Aug. 21-24;**

**Additional E Cherry Street intersection closures postponed until further notice**

The intersection of E Jefferson Street and 23rd Avenue will be closed to traffic from Friday, Aug. 21 to Monday, Aug. 24 for crews to demolish and pave the intersection. Due to a schedule change, the upcoming closures of the E Cherry Street intersection have been postponed until further notice. There will be no weekend work Aug. 14-17.

### Work hours

- **Crews will work continuously from 7 PM, Friday, Aug. 21 to 6 AM, Monday, Aug. 24.**
- Crews will be working to demolish the street, complete a water main connection, and repave the intersection.
- This work is dependent on weather and the completion of preliminary water main work, and may need to be rescheduled.
- Additional work at this intersection may be required at a later date.

### Construction impacts


- Noise, dust and vibration expected throughout all hours of the weekend.
- The contractor will obtain a noise variance to complete this work.
- The noisiest work (breaking pavement, saw cutting, use of jackhammers) will be prohibited between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM.

### Traffic impacts

- The E Jefferson Street intersection will be completely closed to traffic.
- Detour routes will be clearly posted; follow the signed detours and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets.
- The northbound 23rd Avenue detour to Martin Luther King Jr Way will remain in place.

### Access to businesses

- Customers can continue to access businesses by car, by driving into the local access areas, or on foot.
- Please continue to support your local businesses!



### Transit, bicycle and pedestrian information

- Metro bus routes #3, #4 and #48, as well as their bus stops, will be affected by this work. Look for posted Rider Alerts and learn more by calling Metro at 206-553-3000.
- Bicyclists should also detour around these intersections during this work.
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained.

### Water interruptions

- Seattle Public Utilities will provide notice to businesses and residents who will experience temporary water shut-offs while crews work on the new water main.
