

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
2014 PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS – SOUTH, RAINIER GROUP**

Description of proposal: SDOT is planning to construct a sidewalk along 23rd Ave S from S Waite St to S College St and along two blocks of S College St between 23rd Ave S and Rainier Ave S. The project will construct curb bulbs and ramps at Rainier Ave S and S Walker St, and curb ramps at the intersections of 23rd Ave S and S Walker St and MLK Jr Way S and S Walker St. New open space will be constructed on the east side of 23rd Ave S at, and just north of, S Bayview St.
