



## MICROSURFACING PLANNED FOR AUGUST 6

As early as Saturday, August 6, crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will apply a microsurfacing overlay to streets in Southeast Ballard and South Wallingford. This overlay extends the life of the pavement. You may see preparatory work in the area a few days prior such as removing pavement markings. The maps on the back show the specific timing of work in your neighborhood. Please review this notice and contact our outreach team using the information below with questions or concerns.

### What to expect

- 2 to 3 days before the work begins, crews will distribute confirmation notices with dates and instructions to prepare for microsurfacing, and place “No Parking” signs on streets.
- Noise, tar-like odors, and large equipment are expected with the work.
- Streets and portions of the Burke-Gilman Trail will be closed for up to 8 hours; the average closure is 4 to 6 hours. Please avoid the road surface during this time. When wet, the microsurfacing emulsion is sticky and difficult to remove from clothing and pet fur.
- Crews will sequence work to maintain access to parking lots, garages, and the Burke-Gilman Trail when feasible. “Trail Closed” signs will be posted in affected areas on the day of the work.
- Emergency vehicles will be allowed through the work area immediately.

### Actions for residents and businesses

- Cars must be relocated off the road and planting strip area prior to the start of work. On the day of microsurfacing, please remove all personal items from the road and park cars on a nearby block not being microsurfaced that day. Streets cannot be driven on while closed.
- Please plan alternate routes around affected areas of the Burke-Gilman Trail during the work.
- If it is your normal garbage, recycling, or yard waste pick-up day, please have bins to the curb for collection by 6 AM.
- Please do not wash cars or water lawns the day before or during the work.
- Please keep children and animals away from the area during the work.
