



SDOT Parklet and Sidewalk Café Application Decision

An application for a parklet permit and a sidewalk café permit accessory to Montana Bar has been received by the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT). This application was approved with modifications and conditions:

- Approved parklet dimensions: 28' long x 6' wide
- Approved sidewalk café dimensions: 15'-8" long x 5'-6" wide
- Modifications to submitted plans
 - No overhead canopy
- Conditions of the permit
 - Keep parklet free and open to all members of the public
 - Keep parklet and sidewalk café well maintained and in good repair with daily cleaning
 - Keep parklet and sidewalk café free of debris, grime, and graffiti
 - Water and maintain parklet vegetation
 - Lock or stow all movable furniture each night
 - Clear out and rinse the area beneath the parklet at least weekly, ensuring that drainage flow along the curb and gutter is not impeded
 - Provide pest control as needed
 - No table service or alcohol in the parklet (table service must be confined to the café)
 - No smoking in the parklet or sidewalk café
 - Renewal is required annually

The request must identify the application number, grounds for objecting to the decision based on City standards, and the specific remedy being proposed (SMT 15.04.112).
