A Growing Transportation Problem



> A TROUBLED SYSTEM:

Our transportation infrastructure was not built to last forever. Time and extensive use have taken their toll. Every neighborhood, business district and industrial area has been impacted by the reduction in transportation funding.

- ▶ Maintenance backlog over \$500 million.
- ▶ In 10-15 years, if funding levels remain the same, the maintenance backlog will be over \$1 billion dollars.
- ▶ Over a third of Seattle's bridges need major repair or replacement.
- ▶ Most of Seattle's 586 retaining walls, built to last up to 40 years, will not be replaced for at least 250 years.
- ▶ Two-thirds of Seattle's primary streets are older than their design life.
- ▶ A third of Seattle's sidewalks are in poor condition.
- ▶ Half of Seattle's 120,000 traffic signs are in poor condition.
