Neighborhood greenways are residential streets that are safer and more family-friendly for people walking or biking. They improve the experience for people of all ages and abilities by reducing car speeds; minimizing cut-through traffic; and enhancing crossings of busy streets for pedestrians and those riding bikes. Over the past year, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) has been gathering input and studying a neighborhood greenway along NW 58th Street from the Burke-Gilman Trail at Seaview Avenue NW to Fourth Avenue NW. The plan has been revised and we'd like to share the results. SDOT is also evaluating a network of greenways to the north.
