## BALLARD NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY

As soon as August 24, SDOT will begin construction of a new greenway in your neighborhood. See inside for more information about the improvements coming to your street and what to expect during construction.



## CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON AUGUST 24

On August 24, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin constructing improvements to make it safer for people to walk, bike, and drive in the neighborhood.

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will notify residents in advance of driveway closures. Contact us at [BallardGreenway@seattle.gov](mailto:BallardGreenway@seattle.gov) to receive email updates. Work is expected to last approximately four months.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Temporary on-street parking restrictions
- Short-term single lane closures, where needed
- Pedestrian and bicyclist detours
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction
- Weekday work hours from 7 AM to 4 PM
- Maintained access to businesses and residences

### ELEMENTS OF THIS GREENWAY INCLUDE:

- Speed humps and all-way stops
- Wayfinding signage and pavement markings throughout the corridor
- Crossing improvements, including striped crosswalks, curb extensions and flashing beacons
- Reducing the vehicle speed limit to 20 MPH
- Spot pavement and sidewalk repairs

### WHAT IS A NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY?

It's a residential street made safer and more comfortable for you, your family, and neighbors. Neighborhood greenways start with a good foundation and make small improvements that add up to a big difference. The Ballard Greenway will connect Soundview Playfield at NW 90th Street to Salmon Bay using 17th Avenue NW until it turns onto NW Dock Street and ends at Ballard Avenue NW.

### SEATTLE PUBLIC UTILITIES (SPU) NATURAL DRAINAGE WORK
