

TYPICAL BARRICADE REQUIREMENTS FOR A PLAY STREET

Anything can be used as a barricade as long as it temporarily blocks traffic on the play street. Some examples of a barricade include: trash cans, chairs, traffic cones, tables, etc.

While not required, the visibility of barricades used during hours of darkness is enhanced with reflective tape or warning flashers.

The maximum distance between barricades or between barricades and the curb should be 5 ft.
