

# NORTH BEACON SAFETY CONNECTIONS PROJECT

## When will construction start?

Work is anticipated to begin as early as October 7th.

## How long will construction last?

The entire North Beacon Safety Connections project is expected to be under construction for approximately six months and will be completed in early spring 2015. Construction for individual elements of the project will last 4-9 weeks.

## How will my property be impacted?

While SDOT has been working closely with properties that require Temporary Construction Easements (TCEs) for several months, most properties will not experience substantial impacts. Temporary driveway and walkway restrictions may occur periodically near the work zones.

## Will traffic detours be in place? Where?

Yes. Temporary pedestrian and bicycle restrictions will be in place around work areas during the time that they are under construction. Detour routes will be in place to provide pedestrian and bicycle access around these restrictions.

Beacon Avenue S presents challenges in the topography of the roadway and lacks connectivity to other major arterials. Because of this, a vehicle detour will be in place during normal work hours. The vehicle detour will include the closure of the southbound lanes of Beacon Avenue S between 8th Avenue S and 14th Avenue S. Drivers will be warned of the upcoming closure in SODO and a barricade will be placed in the southbound lane of Beacon Avenue S at the Holgate Street Bridge. This is to allow crews to safely and efficiently build the new sidewalk on Beacon Avenue S. Crews will provide as much access as possible and some pedestrian and bicycle traffic at times, may be allowed through the area with the assistance of flaggers.

## Will my bus be detoured?

No, bus routes are not expected to be impacted.

## Will my bus stop be open?

There will be no bus stop closures during this work.

## Who can I call with any issues during construction?

## What are the construction hours?

Regular work hours are typically between 7 AM and 6 PM with occasional weekend work.

## Will there be parking restrictions during construction?

Yes, parking restrictions will be used to make sure there is enough space for our crews to complete this work safely and efficiently. 72 hours prior to restricting parking, you can expect to see "no parking" signs where restrictions will be in place.

## What types of disturbances can be expected?

Standard noise, dust and vibration associated with sawcutting and concrete removal should be expected.

## Will mail delivery or garbage/recycle pickup be disrupted?

SDOT will work closely with businesses, residents, the postal service and waste management crews to ensure that pickup and delivery services are maintained.
