Add Seattle.gov as a Trusted Site

1. Launch Internet Explorer.
2. Press the ALT key to display the Internet Explorer menu.*



*If you do not see the website address displayed, the browser may be in full screen mode.


- Press F11 to exit full screen mode. The website address will display.



- Press the ALT key. The Internet Explorer menu will display.


3. Select **Tools**.
4. Select **Internet Options**.


5. Select the **Security** tab and click **Trusted Sites**.
6. Click the **Sites** button.




7. Uncheck the **Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone** box.
8. In the **Add this website to the zone:** box, enter `*.seattle.gov`.

9. Click the **Add** button. *.seattle.gov is added to your list of trusted websites.



10. Click **Close**.
11. Click **OK**.

Add Seattle.gov to Compatibility View – IE10

1. Launch Internet Explorer.
2. Press the ALT key to display the Internet Explorer menu.*





- Press F11 to exit full screen mode. The website address will display.




- Press the ALT key. The Internet Explorer menu will display.

4. Select **Compatibility View Settings**.




5. In the **Add this website:** box, enter “*.seattle.gov”.




- Press the ALT key. The Internet Explorer menu will display.




