Project Elements

- New concrete sidewalks and repaved asphalt street on 12th Avenue South
- New concrete sidewalks and raised concrete roadway on Vale (Airport Way to 12th)
- Raised crosswalk just north of S. Bailey
- New street lighting, artwork

Upcoming Activity

Surveyors will likely be out first, and underground utilities located. Also expect some No Park signs and possible work hour lane restrictions on 12th.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Single vehicle lane closures during working hours (normally 7AM - 5PM, M-F)
- Frequent parking restrictions within parking area
- Pedestrian access for businesses during their open hours
- Alternative pedestrian pathways when sidewalks are closed
- Occasional closure of ONE of the following entrances to the project area at a time: S. Bailey, S. Harney, or Airport Way S.
- Occasional periods of noise and dust, particularly during demolition activity
