

Seattle Area Construction Look Ahead May 23, 2013

Please note that many of these projects are weather dependant, and may be cancelled due to inclement weather. Please check the project's website for updates.

Highlights:

May 20: Major traffic revisions for the first phase of the Mercer West project: Mercer between 4th and 9th Ave. N. reduced to two lanes; northbound and southbound SR99 reduced to two lanes in each direction between Valley and Harrison St; northbound SR99 off-ramp to Mercer permanently closed; Broad St. open to two-way traffic between 5th and 9th Ave. N; new signalized intersections at 5th & Harrison, Harrison & Broad, and Republican & Dexter.

May 23: Up to three lanes of southbound I-5 closed between Northgate and the University District Thursday night during installation of pavement markings.

May 24- 27: Northwest Folklife Festival at the Seattle Center.

May 25: March Against Monsanto begins at 12 Noon at Westlake Park. March will go north on 4th Ave. to Cedar St, east on Cedar to 5th Ave. N, north on 5th to the Gates Foundation at Harrison St.
