

Seattle Area Construction Look Ahead November 21, 2013

Highlights:

Week of November 18: Elliott Bay Seawall construction begins with the removal of parking spaces under the Viaduct between Madison St. and Pike St, and the construction of a temporary roadway. Work should be complete by early January 2014.

November 22: Nine Inch Nails concert at KeyArena at 8PM Friday night.

November 23: Lake City Wy. NE reduced to one lane in each direction between NE 143rd St. and NE 140th St. on Saturday during the removal of a tower crane.

November 23: Trans-Siberian Orchestra concerts at KeyArena at 3PM and 8PM on Saturday.

November 24: Boren Ave. fully closed between Howell St. and Stewart St. on Sunday while crews erect a tower crane.

November 24: The Green Lake Gobble run will close streets around Green Lake on Sunday morning.

November 24: The Ugly Sweater Run will take place on streets, sidewalks and trails in Magnuson Park on Sunday morning.
