Highlights:

October 1: The second season of construction begins on the central waterfront - Pike St. to Madison St.

October 1: Access to the Coleman Ferry Dock moves from Spring St. to just south of Madison St.

October 4: Large concrete foundation pour at Amazon's new Headquarters will close multiple streets and sidewalks in Downtown Seattle Saturday.

October 5: Magnolia Run the Bluff 10K and 5K will closed streets and parking lanes in Magnolia Sunday morning.

October 6: Stone Wy. N. closed north of N. 34th St. for up to five days.

October 9: W. Emerson/W. Nickerson St. overpass at the south end of the Ballard Bridge closes for approximately three months.

October 10 - 12: 15th Ave. W. closed at the south end of the Ballard Bridge while sections of an overpass are removed.
