Highlights:

March 14 - 24: Stewart St. reduced to two lanes between Minor Ave. and Boren Ave. during underground vault installation.

March 25 - 27: Sakura-Con at Washington State Convention Center.

March 26: Metro Service Change begins. Changes will impact routes in Northeast and South Seattle, as well as Capitol Hill.

March 26: 2nd Ave. closed between Pike St. and Union St. during a tower crane erection.

April 1 - 3: SR520 closed between Montlake and Bellevue for Grand Opening events.

April 1 - 4: Intersection of Stewart Ave. & Boren Ave. reduced to one lane in each direction.




