Traffic impacts will include: nighttime bridge closures five nights per week (Sunday night to Friday morning); the bridge will be closed west of Delridge Way from 9 PM until 5 AM the next morning (on evenings when the Mariners or Sounders are playing, the bridge closure will be delayed until 11 PM); temporary closure of the parking underneath the sections of bridge being worked upon day and night, as well as a temporary closure of the Metro bus stop located at this location.
