Highlights:

July 21 & 22: Nighttime lane and ramp closures on northbound I-5 through Downtown.

July 22 - 24: Capitol Hill Block Party will close E. Pike St. between Broadway and 12th Ave.

July 22 - 25: 23rd Ave. & E. Union St. intersection closed.

July 22 - 25: Southbound I-5 reduced to two lanes south of Seattle while crews replace concrete panels. This is the second of five weekend lane reductions.

July 22 - 25: University Bridge fully closed while crews repave the roadway.
