

Highlights:

- July 8-10, 15th Ave NE will be closed between NE 45th St and NE Ravenna Blvd through the weekend. NE 45th and 50th St will remain open. Buses normally using 15th Ave NE will run on University Way NE.
- July 8-11, the SR 520 Bridge will be closed between Montlake Ave and I-405. The I-5 on/off ramps to and from Mercer St will also be closed throughout the weekend.
- July 11, crews will begin re-paving Rainier Ave S between S Walden St and S Alaska St. Two-way traffic will be maintained.
- July 12-14, the westbound direction of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed each night between I-5 and SR 99.
