

# Seattle Area Construction Look Ahead

**Highlights:**

- Jan 16-20 and 23-27, the Fautleroy Expressway will be closed each night. This is the portion of the West Seattle Freeway west of Delridge on/off-ramps and east of 35th Ave SW.
- Jan 20, expect rolling slowdowns on SR 99, south of the Battery Street Tunnel, to clear drains in anticipation of the melting snow and ice.
- Jan 23 and 25-26, all eastbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed overnight (9PM to 5AM), east of the 1st Ave S off-ramp. Traffic will be detoured to the lower roadway (S Spokane St).
- Jan 27-30, all eastbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed through the weekend, east of the SR 99 off-ramp. Access to the 1st Ave S and 4th Ave S off-ramps will be closed.
