

# Seattle Area Construction Look Ahead

**Highlights:**

- Feb 2-3, Feb 6-10 and Feb 13-17, the eastbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed each night (Monday nights-Friday nights), east of the 1st Ave S off-ramp. Lower S Spokane St will also be closed each night. See below for details.
- Feb 2-3, and Feb 6-10, the Fauntleroy Expressway will be closed each night (Monday nights through Friday nights), both eastbound and westbound. This is the portion of the West Seattle Bridge west of Delridge on/off-ramps and east of 35th Ave SW.
- Feb 3-6 and Feb 10-13, the intersection of 8th Ave NW and NW 85th St will be closed Friday night through Monday morning. A detour will be in place to direct traffic around the closure.
- Feb 13-16, 1st Ave S will be closed each night, both northbound and southbound, between Railroad Way S and S King St in SODO.
