

Highlights:

- April 16-19, the southbound lanes of the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed between Denny Way and S Spokane St overnight. The southbound on-ramps from Elliott Ave and Columbia St will also be closed.
- April 12, the Aurora Ave N (SR 99) off-ramp to Denny Way will be closed overnight. This will also reduce SR 99 to one lane.
- April 12, the 4th Ave off-ramp from the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed for 6-8 weeks while the old, southern lanes of the roadway are resurfaced. The 1st Ave off-ramp will remain open.
- April 13, the southbound Aurora Ave N (SR 99) exit to Broad St will be closed around the clock until further notice.
- April 13-16, Fairview Ave N will be closed between Mercer St and Republican St through the weekend. Traffic exiting I-5 at Mercer St will be directed north towards Valley St. Mercer St will remain open.
