

**Highlights:**

- As of 5AM on May 10th, Alaskan Way was closed between S King St and Madison St. Two-way traffic has been routed underneath the Alaskan Way Viaduct and will reconnect with Alaskan Way proper between Madison St and Spring St.
- May 11-12, the intersection of NW 85th St and Greenwood Ave N will be closed Friday night through Saturday evening.
- May 11-14, the I-5 on/off-ramps to/from Mercer St, including the Express Lane ramps, are closed beginning Friday night through Monday morning. The northbound I-5 on-ramp from University St will also be closed.
- May 17, all westbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed between I-5 and SR 99 overnight. The off-ramp from southbound SR 99 to the West Seattle Bridge will remain open.
- May 18-21, the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed between Denny Way and S Spokane St in both directions Friday night through Monday morning. All on- and off-ramps will also be closed.
