


Highlights:

- **May 17 and 21-22, all westbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed between I-5 and SR 99 overnight. The off-ramp from southbound SR 99 to the West Seattle Bridge will remain open.**
- **May 18-21, the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed between Denny Way and S Spokane St in both directions Friday night through Monday morning. All on- and off-ramps will also be closed.**
- **May 20, Beat the Bridge will close both the University Bridge and the Montlake Bridge in the morning hours.**
- **May 22-23, all lanes of eastbound SR 520 will be closed between Montlake Blvd and 92nd Ave NE each night.**
- **May 23, the Aurora Bridge will be fully closed overnight. Northbound, the closure will begin at N 39th St. Southbound, the closure will begin at Western Ave.**
