





- **May 29, the Aurora Bridge will be fully closed overnight. Southbound, the closure will begin at 10PM. Northbound, the closure will begin at midnight.**
- **May 29, the southbound off-ramp from SR 99 to S Atlantic St will be closed overnight.**
- **May 30, all lanes of westbound SR 520 will be closed between 92nd Ave NE and Montlake Blvd overnight.**
- **June 1-4, the SR 520 Bridge will be closed between Montlake and I-405 through the weekend.**
