


Highlights:

- As of 5AM on May 30, the 1st Ave S off-ramp from eastbound Spokane Street Viaduct is closed for up to four weeks. The 4th Ave S off-ramp will remain open during this time.
- June 1-4, the SR 520 Bridge will be closed between Montlake and I-405 through the weekend.
- June 9-11, all westbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed at 6PM Saturday evening through 5AM Monday morning between I-5 and SR 99.
- June 15-18, the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed between Denny Way and S Spokane St in both directions Friday night through Monday morning. All on- and off-ramps will also be closed.
