

Southbound Alaskan Way Viaduct Closed June 11-14, 9PM-5AM nightly



Highlights:

- **June 14, the southbound direction of the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed overnight between the Battery Street Tunnel and the West Seattle Bridge. Southbound on-/off-ramps will also be closed.**
- **June 15-18, the Alaskan Way Viaduct (SR 99) will be closed between Denny Way and S Spokane St in both directions Friday night through Monday morning. All on- and off-ramps will also be closed.**
- **June 16, crews will close the right hand curb lane and the middle lane on Aurora Ave N between the Aurora Bridge and Harrison St during the day (7am to 3pm). The lane closures will allow crews to make critical repairs to the roadway.**
- **June 18-19, the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed to eastbound traffic, east of the SR 99 off-ramp from the West Seattle Bridge. Traffic wishing to reach I-5 or SODO will be directed to the lower roadway (SW Spokane St). Access will be maintained to SR 99 via the West Seattle Bridge off-ramp.**
- **June 20, all westbound lanes of the Spokane Street Viaduct will be closed overnight between I-5 and SR 99. Southbound access from SR 99 to the West Seattle Bridge will be maintained.**
