

Highlights:

- 1st Ave S off ramp from EB Spokane St Viaduct has been reopened.
- June 22 - 25, the intersection at Aurora Ave N at N 85th St will be closed from 10PM Friday to 5AM Monday. One westbound lane will be maintained, all northbound and southbound traffic will be detoured to 15 Ave NW and I-5.
- Until late Oct, eastbound N 85th Street is closed between Greenwood Avenue N and Aurora Avenue N. Traffic is detoured to N 80th Street.
- June 23rd, Rock and Roll Marathon will affect many major streets SR 99, 2nd Ave, S Dearborn St, Rainier Ave S and Lake Washington Blvd S.
- June 24, crews will close the southbound curb lane on Aurora Ave N from the Aurora Bridge to Harrison St during the morning hours of 4AM to 11AM. This work is to install a Business Access and Transit Lane in the right curb lane southbound.
- June 27 & 28, eastbound S Spokane Street will be closed at 4th Ave S (5am to 7pm). Traffic will be detoured to S Lander Street and S Industrial Way.
