

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
2011 - DEXTER AVE. N.**

Description of proposal: As part of its Arterial, Asphalt, and Concrete Program, the City of Seattle, Department of Transportation (SDOT) proposes a maintenance project to resurface the existing roadway of Dexter Ave. N. Proposed work includes intermittent concrete base repair, upgrades to the existing stormwater drainage system, and replacement of sidewalk curb ramps. In addition, the project will remove the center two-way turn lane to allow for parking-protected bike lanes on each side of the street. Dedicated left-turn lanes will be provided at busy intersections along with dedicated load zones for businesses where needed. The project will provide in-lane bus stops and bus islands to improve transit speed and reliability.

The total project area is roughly 466,000 square feet. Base repair or concrete panel replacement will occur in approximately 77, 000 square feet of the project area (1.77 acres).

Location of proposal: Along Dexter Ave. N between 4th Ave. N (Fremont Bridge) to Roy Street in Seattle, Washington.


Lead Agency: SDOT

SDOT has determined that this proposal would not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. Documents are also available at the Downtown Branch (1000 4th Avenue) and University Branch (5009 Roosevelt Way NE) of the Seattle Public Library.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.05.340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the issue date below. **Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. October 11, 2010.**
