

SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
DIRECTOR'S RULE FOR PEDESTRIAN MOBILITY IN AND AROUND WORK ZONES

Description of proposal: The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) proposes to issue a revised Director's Rule for Pedestrian Mobility in and Around Work Zones (SDOT DR 10-2015). The expanded rule emphasizes sidewalk closures as a last resort, when there is no other reasonable solution to keep a public walkway open. The updated rule establishes standards for meeting Seattle Municipal Code requirements, including materials, their placement, and steps to ensure American Disability Act (ADA) compliance.

Location of proposal including street address, if any: The rule applies to public rights of way in Seattle.


Lead Agency: SDOT
