## Ballard Neighborhood Greenway - NW Dock Pl and Leary Ave NW

### Construction Phasing Update – Additional street access restrictions starting as early as Thursday, December 17

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is building pedestrian safety improvements (enhanced pedestrian/bicycle signal, curb ramps and crosswalks) at the intersection of NW Dock Pl and Leary Ave NW as part of the Ballard Neighborhood Greenway Project. In order to complete this work, access to NW Dock Pl from Leary Ave NW will be temporarily restricted around the clock for up to 4 weeks. This work started on Monday, December 14.

### UPDATED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND TRAFFIC ADVISORY

SDOT's contractor's construction schedule has been expedited. The contractor now plans to work on both sides of Leary Ave NW at the intersection with NW Dock Pl for approximately 4 weeks.

This replaces the flyer we distributed last week that explained work would occur in 2 phases (starting on the north side and then moving to the south side of the intersection).

For approximately 4 weeks:

- Leary Ave NW will be reduced to one lane in both directions to accommodate the work zones on the north and south sides of the intersection.
- Northbound access to NW Dock Pl from Leary Ave NW will be closed to through traffic. Those needing local access to NW Dock Pl are encouraged to use Russell Ave NW via NW lone Pl.
- Southbound access to NW Dock Pl from Leary Ave NW will be closed to through traffic. Those needing local access to NW Dock Pl are encouraged to use Ballard Ave NW via NW 48th St or NW lone Pl.
- Temporary pedestrian paths and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps will be clearly marked and installed just north and south of the work zones.

Crews will install the enhanced pedestrian/bicycle signal and crosswalks after the curb ramps are installed.



### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION AT NW DOCK PL AND LEARY AVE NW

- Lane restrictions on Leary Ave NW with maintained two-way traffic
- Temporary access restrictions on NW Dock Pl
- Normal weekday work hours from 7 AM to 5 PM
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction
- Pedestrian and bicyclist detours, including temporary ADA-compliant ramps

**This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.**

**Crews will work on December 24, but not on December 25.**

### What you need to know about the enhanced pedestrian and bicycle signal on Leary Ave NW

- Vehicles traveling on the greenway (NW Dock Pl) will be controlled by a stop sign.
- The new signal on Leary Ave NW at NW Dock Pl will stop traffic on Leary Ave NW only when activated by a vehicle, pedestrian, or bike wanting to cross Leary Ave NW.
