

What is SDOT doing to address neighborhood traffic concerns?

SDOT may use the following tools to keep people safe and help keep traffic moving:

Safety



Traffic speed and volume studies



Uniformed Police Officers (UPOs) and flaggers



Increased parking on neighborhood streets



Speed trailer to show current traffic speeds

Mobility



Signal timing modifications



Left turn restrictions



Parking restrictions



Detour Signage
