1	View from Westlake Avenue facing southwest toward the south bridge approach, with the access road to the SDOT maintenance shop on the right.
2	View facing northwest, looking at the south bridge approach from below, with the South Ship Canal Path on the left and the maintenance shop on the right.
3	View of the east side of the Fremont Bridge, facing north. Armored banks on the north side of the canal are shown in the background, vegetation on the south bank is shown in the foreground.
4	View from the southwest side of the south bridge approach, facing east. Alder and willow provide limited shading over the canal south bank. This is the only portion of the project site in which vegetation provides shading.
5	View of the northwest bridge approach from the south shoreline, facing north.
6	View of the north shoreline and east side of the bridge from the mid-span of the bridge, showing the armored and landscaped north shoreline.
7	View of the area underneath the north bridge approach, with the Burke-Gilman Trail on the right.

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




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
