



## Phase 1 – Renton Ave S Repaving Project

Repaving of Renton Ave S between S Trenton St and 51st Ave S postponed until March 2016

Renton Ave S is a minor arterial street serving approximately 8,800 southeast Seattle commuters, transit users and commercial vehicles daily. The project area (shown on map) extends along Renton Ave S from S Holden St to 51st Ave S. To improve safety for users of this corridor, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) installed 65 new curb ramps in 13 locations and nine new curb bulbs between S Holden St and 51st Ave S during the fall of 2015. SDOT also repaved the roadway surface from S Holden St to S Trenton St during the fall of 2015. Due to winter weather conditions, repaving of the roadway from S Trenton St to 51st Ave S has been postponed until March 2016.

SDOT will provide more detailed information on repaving activities and impacts to nearby neighbors and businesses before construction resumes in spring 2016.

This project is funded by the voter-approved Bridging the Gap levy as part of SDOT's Arterial Asphalt and Concrete (AAC) Program.
