

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
2014 PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS-LAKE CITY WAY NE & NE 145TH CURB RAMPS**

Description of Proposal: Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) plans to install curb ramps on the south side of Lake City Way NE and NE 145th intersection. A new signal mast arm will also be installed on the southwest corner and Accessible Pedestrian Signals added at all crossings. In order to construct Americans with Disabilities Act compliant ramps, SDOT will acquire 177 sq. feet of new right of way.

Location of proposal including street address, if any: The project location is the southeast and southwest corners of the Lake City Way NE and NE 145th Street intersection in Seattle Washington, 98125.

SDOT has determined that this proposal would not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. Documents are also located in the Lake City Branch of the Seattle Public Library, at 12501 28th Ave. NE, Seattle, WA, 98125.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.05.340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the issue date below. **Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. April 10, 2014**
