

Linden Avenue Complete Street Project

Progress Report and Upcoming Construction Update

September 28, 2012



What to Expect During Construction:

All travelers are advised to use caution while traveling through the work zone and expect:

- Construction noise and dust and increased construction truck traffic
- Partial or full-width gravel roadways, grooved pavement, and loose asphalt
- Raised utility castings and man holes in the street
- Frequent lane closures, detours and traffic delays
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours; bicyclists will merge and share the lane with general northbound traffic, or may use sidewalks
- Long-term parking and loading restrictions; on-street parking restrictions will be ongoing 24 hours a day, seven (7) days a week

Project Work Hours and Schedule

Work hours are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday with possible weekend work from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturdays and Sundays.

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) continues construction to redevelop Linden Avenue North between North 128th and North 145th streets into a neighborhood-friendly roadway that is safer for all users.

Linden Avenue between N 128th Street and N 130th streets:

Work will continue to complete landscaping and roadway paving. The road will remain closed intermittently to all traffic through October, followed by one lane of northbound travel through late November. Work in this area is expected to continue for a month and a half.

Linden Avenue between N 130th Street and N 135th streets:

Crews will continue working to install storm drainage structures in preparation for the new roadway, curbs, gutters and sidewalks. Work in this stretch of roadway is expected to continue for the next 5 months. Southbound traffic will be detoured; however, parking restrictions will be ongoing and will move along the corridor as work progresses.

Linden Avenue between N 135th Street and North 141st streets:

Construction will continue as crews complete the installation of sidewalks, curbs and bioswales and complete landscaping. This stretch of roadway will reopen to southbound traffic when crews are not working in the area. Work is expected to continue for 2 months.

Linden Avenue between N 141st and 145th streets:

Construction will continue as crews complete landscaping, roadway paving and striping. Work is expected to last for 1 month, and southbound traffic will remain detoured.
