## Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

### Anticipated Schedule for 9th Ave. N. Construction

Work continues to install a new sewer line beneath 9th Ave. N, leading up to additional construction activities from the spring through the early fall of 2011. The schedule below outlines the scope and approximate time periods for these upcoming activities, including:

- **Complete Sewer Replacement:** Installation of a new 30-inch diameter sewer line between Aloha St. and Broad St. Anticipate completion in mid-spring, allowing roadway construction to begin.
- **Rebuild Roadway Surface and Sidewalks:** The entire roadway will be rebuilt between Aloha St. and Mercer St., including sidewalks. **Access to businesses will be maintained during construction.**
- **Utility work:** Replace water and gas lines, install new underground electrical and communications lines and remove existing electrical poles on west side of 9th Ave. N.
- **Install Street Lights and Traffic Signals:** Traffic signals will be installed at Westlake Ave. N and 9th Ave. N, where the intersection will be reconfigured for two-way traffic on both streets.
