

Construction Notice

Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

July 28, 2011

The following construction activities are anticipated in early August:

Nighttime closure of northbound Westlake Ave. N between Mercer St. and Valley St.

Beginning as early as Monday, August 1, all northbound lanes of Westlake Ave. N between Mercer St. and Valley St. will be closed overnight to accommodate utility installations. Northbound traffic, including King County Metro bus routes will be detoured via Terry Ave. N which will be reopened during nighttime work hours only. Southbound traffic will continue on Westlake Ave. N.

What & Where: Northbound lanes of Westlake Ave. N closed between Mercer St. and Valley St.

Why: Installation of underground utilities.

Work Hours: Nighttime work, 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Duration: Approximately one week.

Nighttime lane closures on Mercer St. at Boren Ave. N and Terry Ave. N


Beginning as early as Monday, August 8, up to three lanes of Mercer St. will be intermittently closed overnight at Boren Ave. N and Terry Ave. N to accommodate water main installation. Terry Ave. N and Boren Ave. N will be closed to through traffic between Republican St. and Mercer St.

What & Where: Mercer St. at Boren Ave. N and Mercer St. at Terry Ave. N.


Why: Water main installation crossing Mercer St.

Work Hours: Nighttime work, 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Duration: Intermittent for approximately three weeks.



Westlake Ave. N night work to begin August 1 and continue one week.



Boren Ave. N and Terry Ave. N night work in early August.
