



MICROSURFACING BEGINS AS EARLY AS AUGUST 19

As early as Friday, August 19, 2016, crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will apply a microsurfacing overlay to streets in the Madison Valley, Madrona, and Leschi neighborhoods. This overlay extends the life of the pavement. You may have seen preparatory work in the area already, such as removing pavement markings. Please review this notice, including the 2 maps that show the specific timing of work in your neighborhood, and contact our outreach team with questions or concerns.

What to expect

- 2 to 3 days before the work begins, crews will distribute confirmation notices with dates and instructions to prepare for microsurfacing, and place “No Parking” signs on streets.
- Noise, tar-like odors, and large equipment are expected with the work.
- Streets and portions of signed bike routes will be closed for up to 8 hours; the average closure is 4 to 6 hours. Please avoid the road surface during this time and follow signed detours. When wet, the microsurfacing emulsion is sticky and difficult to remove from clothing and pet fur.
- Emergency vehicles will be allowed through the work area immediately.

Actions for residents, business operators, and employees

- Cars must be relocated off the road and planting strip area prior to the start of work. On the day of microsurfacing, please remove all personal items from the road and park cars on a nearby block not being microsurfaced that day. Streets cannot be driven on while closed.
- For people biking, plan an alternate route around affected bike routes during the work.
- Please keep children and animals away from the area during the work.
- If it is your normal garbage, recycling, or yard waste pick-up day, have bins to the curb by 6 AM for collection. We will not impact pick-up.
- Please do not wash cars or water lawns the day before or during the work.
