



# N 92ND STREET PROTECTED BIKE LANE PROJECT

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

We're redesigning N 92nd St to improve safety and predictability for everyone using the street, and building out the citywide multimodal transportation network. Our proposal would add protected bike lanes from Wallingford Ave N to 1st Ave NE across Interstate 5.

The bus stops and two travel lanes that are there today would remain. However, some on-street parking spaces would be impacted by this proposal. See map below. We are recommending that residents use driveways, the gravel parking spaces that will remain, and nearby side streets for any on-street parking needs.

The goal of the project is to make North Seattle transportation safer for everyone - whether you're walking, driving, biking, taking transit, or moving goods.
