

Start of Construction Notice

NE Ravenna Blvd Paving Project 2012 Arterial Asphalt Concrete

March 8, 2012

Construction begins March 21st

Expect lane closures and parking restrictions

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is preparing to repave NE Ravenna Blvd, between E. Greenlake Dr N and 15th Ave NE. Work will begin the week of March 19th and start on the east side of NE Ravenna Blvd near Woodlawn Ave N.

Project Area and Construction Schedule

Work will be separated into two phases to minimize construction impacts to the surrounding neighborhood. Weather permitting construction will be completed by the end of the summer.

- **Phase One** – NE Ravenna Blvd from E Greenlake Dr N to 8th Ave NE
- **Phase Two** – NE Ravenna Blvd from 8th Ave NE to 15th Ave NE

Project Work Hours: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday with occasional night work.

Project Elements

- Grinding and removing the existing asphalt roadway
- Repairing select areas of underlying concrete roadway base
- Repaving the roadway with a new asphalt layer
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps
- Building a curb bulb at E Greenlake Dr N and NE 71st St


Traffic Restrictions

Traffic will be reduced to one lane near work zones. During significant construction activities, such as grinding and final paving, portions of the roadway will be closed and traffic will be detoured.

On-street parking will be temporarily removed and loading restrictions may be in place. Advance notice will be provided.

The **bike lane** will be closed at times during construction and appropriate signage will be used to guide bicyclists through or around the work zone for the duration of the project.

When near work zone all travelers should use caution, reduce speeds and keep a safe distance from construction equipment.



What to Expect During Construction:

- Lane closures
- Parking and loading restrictions
Note: Vehicles parked in No Parking zones may be towed
- Pedestrian and bike detours
- Construction noise and dust
- Short-term driveway restrictions
- Occasional night work and street closures
- Some tree trimming

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Regular updates as the project moves forward.
