## Renton Ave S Repaving Project: Phase 2 to begin June 15

Parking restrictions along Renton Ave S from 51st Ave S to S Ryan St for up to three months

Repaving of Renton Ave S between 51st Ave S and S Ryan St will begin Wednesday, June 15. Crews will install curb ramps and curb bulbs, and grind and repave the roadway for approximately the next three months. Crews will also install upgraded pedestrian crossing signals at the intersection at Renton Ave S and S Ryan St.

Parking will not be allowed on Renton Ave S between 51st Ave S and S Ryan St during grinding and paving operations. Parking may also be restricted at times near other work areas; please observe the No Parking signage.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Expect delays on Renton Ave S during construction
- No parking on Renton Ave S between 51st Ave S and S Ryan St
- Two-way traffic flows on Renton Ave S, with vehicles shifted to one side of the street to provide a work zone on the opposite side
- Sidewalks will generally remain open; some pedestrian detour routes will be required
- Flaggers will be positioned at cross streets to direct traffic and assist pedestrians
- Pavement will be rough after grinding and prior to paving
- Driveways will be kept open for access, except for very short periods while grinding and paving street next to driveway
- Noise, dust and vibration near work zone
- Long work hours: 7 AM to 7 PM
- Reduced speed limits and longer travel times in project area

**This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.**

### UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

#### RENTON AVE S FROM 51ST AVE TO S RYAN ST

Crews will work on curb bulbs and repaving on the east half of the street (with traffic to the west) and then move the work zone to the west side of the street.

#### Curb bulb ramp installation begins Wednesday, June 15

- Crews will replace curb ramps and sections of sidewalk at intersections.
- This work will take approximately one month to complete.

#### Street surface repair and repaving planned to begin Monday, July 11

- SDOT's contractor will grind the road to remove the top layer of asphalt
- After the top layer of asphalt is removed, repairs will be made to the base layer as needed to support the installation of new pavement
- Once the base layer is repaired, new pavement will be placed and compacted
- Temporary road striping (crosswalks and lane markers) will be installed after paving
- Permanent striping will be installed at the end of the project in the fall of 2016
- This work will take up to six days to complete

#### Pedestrian crossing signal work may begin as soon as Monday, July 11

- SDOT's contractor will upgrade and relocate pedestrian crossing signals
- When needed, uniformed police officers will direct traffic through the intersection
- This work is expected to take five weeks to complete

**When work between 51st Ave S and S Ryan St is complete, crews will make similar improvements on the section of Renton Ave S between S Ryan St and S 112th Pl.**



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## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Renton Avenue South is a minor arterial serving approximately 8,800 Southeast Seattle commuters, bike riders, transit users and commercial vehicles daily. To improve safety for these users, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is repaving the road and installing new curb ramps and curb bulbs between S Holden St and S 112th Pl. Phase 1 work, from S Holden St to 51st Ave S, was completed in spring 2016. The construction identified in this notice is Phase 2 (51st Ave S to S 112th Pl) and is expected to take six months to complete.
