

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## Renton Avenue South Repaving Project

Renton Avenue South is a minor arterial street serving approximately 8,800 southeast Seattle commuters, transit users and commercial vehicles daily. To improve safety for these users, the Seattle Department of transportation will install over 40 new curb ramps and nine new curb bulbs between South Holden Street and 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue SE this fall.

**Beginning Tuesday, September 1st**, you may begin seeing crews along Renton Avenue South. Crews will begin work on the north end of the project, near South Holden Street, and proceed south.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

#### Curb ramp and curb bulb construction (September – November):

- Replace sections of sidewalk and curb at intersections
- Pedestrian detours around work zones, use alternative crossings or temporary pathways
- Temporary loss of parking spaces near construction areas
- Bicyclists merge with traffic near construction areas
- Short term closures of side streets and/or flaggers directing traffic

#### Repaving of Renton Avenue South (November):

- Detour on Renton Avenue S for all traffic in one direction for several days
- Short-term loss of access to driveways as pavement cools

#### General Impacts:

- Reduced speed limits and longer travel times in project area
- Typical work schedule Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM
- Noise, dust, and vibration near work zones
