The Seattle Department of Transportation is preparing to repave Roosevelt Way NE between the north end of the University Bridge and NE 65th Street. In addition, the project will construct curb bulbs to shorten pedestrian crossing distances at some key intersections, replace substandard curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and install a protected bike lane on the west side of Roosevelt south of NE 45th Street to address safety concerns. Should additional funding be secured, the project will also replace buckled or broken sidewalks, install in-lane bus stops at four locations, and install brighter energy-saving LED streetlights on the west side of the street. Construction is slated to begin in summer 2015, and take about ten months to complete.

Corridor improvements

Roosevelt Way NE is a major arterial, serving motorists, bus riders, pedestrians, and people on bikes. Its poor condition makes repaving it a SDOT priority.

The Roosevelt Way AAC (Arterial Asphalt & Concrete) Paving Project between the north end of the University Bridge and NE 65th Street will:

- Repave the roadway
- Install a protected bike lane on the west side of Roosevelt between NE 45th and the south side of the University Bridge to address safety concerns
- Install curb bulbs to shorten pedestrian crossing distances at key intersections
- Replace substandard corner curb ramps to meet federal ADA requirements

Additionally, if funding is secured, the project will also:

- Replace buckled or broken sidewalks
- Install bright, energy-saving LED street lights on the west side of Roosevelt

Construction is slated to begin in summer 2015, and take about ten months to complete.



Protected bike lane

In the past four years, there have been 17 collisions involving people riding bikes between NE 45th and NE 40th streets. We are accelerating the implementation of a protected bike lane to make it safer for people riding bikes and to add predictability for all travelers. Construction of the temporary protected bike lane will take place in December/January, weather permitting. A permanent facility will be constructed with the paving project in summer 2015.
