Intersection of Fairview Avenue North and Valley Street

A modern streetcar is coming to South Lake Union, Denny Triangle and the Downtown Retail Core. By the end of 2007, the Seattle Streetcar will be connecting over 330,000 riders annually to the places they live, work and socialize.


The City of Seattle and its contractor will be installing the first streetcar rail in the intersection of Fairview Avenue North and Valley Street. This work will feature shallow track-way excavation and installation of over 100 feet of pre-curved rail.

Typical streetcar rail construction will occur during normal business hours and will not require the closure of streets or intersections to general purpose traffic. However, to minimize impacts in high traffic areas like the intersection of Fairview Avenue North and Valley Street, which is a major connection point to and from Interstate 5, construction crews will work around the clock over two weekends to install the rail.

Closures will occur September 30th - October 1st and October 6th - 8th.

The traffic control plan will include lane restrictions on the Interstate 5 Mercer Exit, Fairview Avenue North and Valley Street. See map for details. Detour routes will be provided.
