

15th Avenue NE Reconstruction – Weekly Project Update

April 25, 2011 – Issue #17

Construction Activity April 25th – May 1st

The Seattle Department of Transportation is reconstructing 15th Ave NE between NE Pacific St and NE 45th St. In addition to this project, street improvements near the NE 55th St/Ravenna/22nd Ave NE intersection are currently ongoing. Some of the work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

Weekday Work: April 25th to April 29th

Planned work hours: 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

NE Pacific St to NE 45th St

- Trench and install electrical conduit (east side between NE 43rd St and NE 45th St)
- Pull electrical wires through conduits
- Splice electrical wires for signals and light poles

NE 55th St/Ravenna/22nd Ave NE intersection

- Dig bioretention swale in south bulb
- Install rockery in south bulb
- Install plants (approximately 600 units) in south bulb
- Reconfigure roadway lanes in preparation for work on the north side of the intersection next week
