Transit Priority Corridor Improvements - Rainier Corridor

Street Improvements Are Coming Soon: Jackson Street/Rainier Avenue Transit Route Corridor

Estimated Construction Start: Spring 2010

Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) has been working on a comprehensive design for improvements to Bus Route 7 along S Jackson Street and Rainier Avenue S that will enhance the speed and reliability of bus service in the corridor. The design process is nearing an end and the improvements are scheduled to be under construction by spring 2010.

The improvements will create a better waiting environment for bus passengers and improve travel time for buses.


Improvements to S Jackson Street and/or Rainier Avenue S Include:

- Building concrete bus bulb/curb and sidewalk extensions to eliminate buses having to pull in and out of traffic at passenger loading zones.
- Restriping lane markings with changes in travel lanes and parking lanes to improve bus traffic movement and pedestrian safety.
- Making improvements to street lighting and drainage at several locations.
- Modification of the traffic signal system

It will be necessary to permanently remove some existing parking spots at certain locations along Rainier Avenue.

- Lane closures during off-peak hours
- Temporary pedestrian detours
- Temporary parking restrictions
- Moderate construction noise
- Normal work hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. with occasional night time and weekend work
