

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

October 2015

Construction at 21st Ave SW and SW Genesee St, beginning October 5

Beginning Monday, October 5, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will install new sidewalk and curb ramps at the intersection of 21st Ave SW and SW Genesee St. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project and is expected to take up to 5 days to complete.

TRAFFIC CHANGES DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- The intersection at 21st Ave SW and SW Genesee St will be closed to southbound traffic.
- Local access will be maintained.
- Southbound through traffic on 21st Ave SW will be detoured as follows:
 - From 21st Ave SW travel east on SW Charlestown St to 20th Ave SW
 - Then travel south on 20th Ave SW to SW Genesee St
- The intersection at 21st Ave SW and SW Genesee St will remain open to northbound traffic.

PROJECT INFORMATION

Greenways are residential streets made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project that will connect White Center to the West Seattle Bridge Trail. The greenway will run north-south, generally along 17th Ave SW in the south and 21st Ave SW in the north. We anticipate that construction of the greenway will be complete by the end of the year.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING DELRIDGE-HIGHLAND PARK GREENWAY CONSTRUCTION

- Normal weekday work hours of 7 AM to 5 PM
- Traffic restrictions
- Local access maintained
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction

This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.
