

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



January 2016

Storm drain construction south of 21st Ave SW and 22nd Ave SW begins January 15


Beginning on Friday, January 15, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will install a new storm drain on the east side of 21st Ave SW, just south of where 22nd Ave SW merges with 21st Ave SW. Crews will also repair the storm drain on the west side of 21st Ave SW at that intersection. See map at right for storm drain locations.

Also beginning today, crews will continue widening the sidewalk on the west side of 21st Ave SW between 22nd Ave SW and SW Dawson St, necessitating short-term driveway restrictions. Crews will return on dry days to pour concrete for the sidewalks. Advance notice will be provided.

Weather permitting, this work will be complete within 2 to 3 weeks. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project.

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN RESTRICTIONS

- Temporary lane restrictions at the intersection on 21st Ave SW and 22nd Ave SW
- Flaggers on both ends of the work zone will maintain two-way traffic within the one open lane



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Traffic delays along 21st Ave SW between 22nd Ave SW and SW Dawson St
- Weekday work hours from 7 AM to 6 PM
- Temporary lane restrictions
- Flaggers directing traffic
- Two-way traffic will be maintained
- Noise, dust and vibration typical of construction
- Bus routes will not be affected

This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.

PROJECT INFORMATION

Greenways are residential streets made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project that will connect White Center to the West Seattle Bridge Trail. The greenway will run north-south, generally along 17th Ave SW in the south and 21st Ave SW in the north.
